



UAE National Race Day Events at Dubai Autodrome: Television rights and use of on board video cameras

Television rights

1. Dubai Autodrome/Dubai Autodrome Motorsports Club ("DA"), through any nominated film production companies, holds exclusive broadcast, recording, cable, satellite, digital, video, internet and interactive rights and rights to all other media to film and record the participation of the competitor, entrant, sponsor, and any other team member in the events and activities throughout the National Race Day event(s) and to license, assign or otherwise deal with such rights and/or film and recording. The competitor accepts without reservation or recourse the surrender of his/her rights (if any) in such matters which may then be used at DA's discretion.
2. Any competitor, entrant, sponsor, team member or any other person wishing to record the National Race Day event(s) and/or the venue for commercial purposes must get the prior written consent of DA. In addition, DA reserves the right to charge a reasonable fee for said permission and/or for production of coverage.
3. On-board cameras may be permitted, for team/personal use only and explicitly not for broadcasting, and only with the approval of DA who may require additional information.
4. Any competitors advised by the organizers that they are to carry on-board television cameras, may be required to have the approved Championship logo (where relevant) on the dashboard, visible to a forward facing on-board camera. The decision for the positioning of this Logo rests solely with the DAMC and their nominated film production company. Moreover:
 - No other publicity material will be allowed that is visible to an on-board camera, whether on the vehicle or on race suits,
 - Any competitor who fails to meet these requirements may be penalized.
5. Competitors are obliged to assist in promotion of the National Race Day events and associated Championships by the granting of interviews when requested by the nominated film production company and any other reasonable requests of the DAMC.

Additionally:

1. Onboard video footage made by competitors is for personal use only and can only be filmed with the written permission of the Dubai Autodrome Press Officer - see below.
2. Dubai Autodrome reserves the right to impound footage from a competitor's onboard camera and reserves the right to use competitors' footage in whichever way they choose should this be required.
3. Any video footage shot during the event(s) by competitors using on-board video cameras, is not to be used commercially or to be sold to a third party for use commercially or professionally without the prior written approval of the Dubai Autodrome Press Officer – see below. This includes video footage shot for use by individuals and sponsors connected to the competitors.
4. Personal use does not include posting of clips to websites such as YouTube, Facebook and similar websites.
