### **Entries**

All Nat Status entries are considered provisional pending payment of entry fees (AED 1,750 Race Entry fee for Registered TOTAL UAE Touring Car Championship; AED 2,000 Race Entry fee for Non-Registered TOTAL UAE Touring Car Championship; AED 2,750 Race Entry fee for Registered NGK UAE GT Championship Competitors; AED 3,000 Race Entry fee for Non-Registered NGK UAE GT Championship Competitors; Race Entry fees for Suzuki Swift Cup, Radical Cup & Formula Gulf 1000 as per Championship Regulations) in full. Payment can be made via credit card, in cash in person by coming to the Dubai Autodrome (Sunday – Thursday, 09:00 – 17:00hrs) or via cheque.

### **Eligible Competitors**

All competitors in Event A, B, C, D & E must be holders of current, valid and relevant National Race License, ATC UAE or GCC ASN issued National Race License minimum. All competitors must have passed the appropriate Medical and meet any other requirements applicable to the event, its status and/or championship or race/event in question. In addition the competitors must have permission to compete from their license issuing ASN in

accordance with Article 70 of the ISC of the FIA. Licenses, Medical Certificates and permissions will be examined at signing-on.

### **Entry Definitions**

Each entry will qualify for personnel passes and car passes, which will be notified in the Final Instructions, for access to restricted areas of the event. Additional passes may be issued on request from DAMC if required and subject to availability. Each entry will qualify the competitor for a listing in the official program of the sponsor/team name. This listing will be a maximum of six words and must contain no offensive or misleading statements. All other national restrictions on certain types of advertising must be respected.

### **Close of Entries:**

Entries close at 17:00hrs on **Thursday, 8<sup>th</sup> December 2011.**

Entries may be accepted after this date, subject to a 500AED late payment penalty, at the discretion of DAMC and YMC.

### **Acceptance and Refusal of Entries:**

In accordance with the Sporting Regulations of the Championships (Article 2.1)

### **Results and Protests:**

Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each race. Protests should be made in accordance with the Articles 172, 173 and 174 of the present Code. The National Protest fee is AED1,500 and National Appeal Fee is AED 5,000.

### **Start Positions:**

The specific format for the events and qualification for races will be set by Championship Regulations or be advised by the organizers in Final Instructions or an official event bulletin/briefing.

### **Scrutineering Etc:**

All vehicles must comply with Vehicle, Formula and tire regulations. In accordance with Article 128 of the Code, all vehicles must have suitable and sufficient protection for the prevention of passage of flame between engine and drivers seat.

### **Insurance**

All competitors are insured in respect of Third Party Public liability during official testing, practice and racing. They are strongly advised to make their own arrangements with regard to personal accident/injury cover and cover for damage to their vehicles and those of other competitors taking part.

### **Grids:**

Should the entries of cars in each of the races on this event exceed 30; the organizing committee reserves the right to split the grid into two separate races on the grounds of safety.
